This is mom and a wolf. They loved sniffing us humans and they loved our attention (for the most part...some of them lived up to their name of "shy wolf sanctuary" though and stayed far away from us humans).



See the look on this wolf's face...he obviously is enjoying the petting. But check out those huge teeth, especially those two big fangs on the bottom (he has a matching pair of huge fangs like that on the top too that you just can't see in this picture).

I would highly recommend anybody and everybody going out there. You have to make a reservation several months in advance. It's about a 1.5 hour tour. They are located in Golden Gate Estates, but not very far out there. You can get as up close and personal with the wolves as you would like to get. And there is no "charge" -- but they do request donations of any (and all) sizes. We all gave \$10 each I think. That is probably a good amount...unless you are blessed and can give more. They also rehabilitate wolves that are hit by cars or otherwise mangled and make them all better again! They also have more than wolves...like the Florida Panther, a black panther, a cougar/spotted tiger, coyotes, several of those cute little foxes, some sugar gliders, several turtles, also several little prairie dog cute gopher type of things. They also have a few other animals that I can't think of at this moment.
